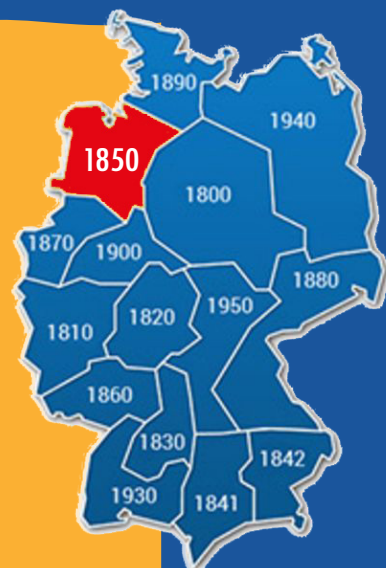

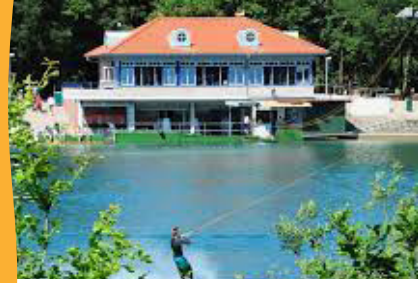
1 THE MUSEUMSDORF IN CLOPPENBURG

Today take a journey back to the 16th to early 20th century. You get a tour through the historical village, you see an old school, a church and get to know a lot about life of our ancestors. In the workshop that follows you are going to cook a tasty stew, done over the fireplace in an historic manor!



2 THE LARGEST BATHING LAKE IN EMSLAND

The crystal-clear Dankernsee offers space for everyone on around 3 kilometers of flat sandy beach! The Dankernsee invites you to swim, build sand castles and enjoy yourself. Explore the lake on a relaxing walk, on a splashy ride on the water ski facility.



3 CANOE TRIP ON THE „HASE“ WOULD YOU LIKE TO DO SOMETHING SPECIAL?

Come with us on a canoe trip. Canoeing is not difficult at all! The basic knowledge is quickly explained and an introduction to the handling of boat and equipment is done in a short time. And you can start with the first paddle strokes. The Hase, which flows into the Ems in Meppen, presents itself as an idyllic hiking river that captivates every paddler. The old arm of the Hase we visit is home to a beautiful biodiversity of plants and animals. Even the kingfisher is at home here!



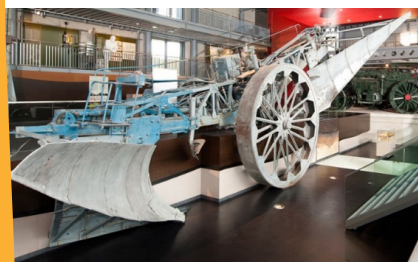
4 THÜLSFELDER TALSPERRE CLIMBING PARK

Up to the stars... well, not that far but way up you are going today! You can climb different levels and master a lot of adventures and challenges... Up in the trees, flying over a lake... always safe and secure, but free like a bird. You need weatherproof clothing and sturdy shoes!



5 EMSLAND MOOR MUSEUM IN GROSS-HESEPE IN THE EMSLAND

The Emsland Moormuseum deals with swamp and its influence on the inhabitants for the past centuries. Furthermore, it enables its visitors to get to know the landscape that characterizes our region and allows them to get a glimpse of Emsland's history. The swamp was the only source of income for the people living here. The hard and exhausting work consisted of cutting peat of the ground to use it as a fuel. Since 1950 larger areas of the swamp were reclaimed as part of the so-called „Emsland plan“ in order to develop the lifestyle and economy of the region, which belonged to the poorest and most backward in Germany. The visitors are also able to see machines, like huge plows, in the tour through the exhibition that were used back then.



Intuitive archery is another highlight of our program. It'll take place on the bank of the river „Ems“ in Lingen under the guidance of coaches. So stay tuned!



6 BREMEN TOUR

Bremen is a major cultural and economic hub of Northern Germany. The city is home to dozens of historical galleries and museums, ranging from historical sculptures to major art museums, such as the Bremen Overseas Museum, the Bremen City Hall and the Bremen Roland are UNESCO Heritage Sites.

Bremen is well known through the Brothers Grimm's Fairy Tale „Town Musicians of Bremen“ and there is a statue dedicated to it in front of the city hall.



7 CLEMENSWERTH CASTLE

A LOOK BEHIND CLOSED DOORS

Clemenswerth Castle is the only completely preserved baroque hunting star system in the world. Eight avenues of linden trees lead to a 42-hectare forest park in a star shape to the central palace surrounded by eight pavilions.

One of these pavilions still houses the castle chapel with an active Capuchin monastery. During the tour, not only exciting things are reported about the builder, who was elector and bishop five times, but otherwise closed doors are also opened.



8 SHIPYARD TOUR OF PAPENBURG

MEYER WERFT and Papenburg are inseparably linked.

You can experience the history of the traditional company, which is now run by the seventh generation of the family, on 3500 square metres of exhibition space.

In a total of nine exhibition areas with original components, including four balcony cabins of modern cruise ships, a gigantic „ship's propeller“ and 20 impressive ship models, you will get an impression of how great things are created at MEYER WERFT.
