- Day 1: Arrive and meet the group for 2 nights camping homestay together
- Day 2: Discover the Netherlands:
Climb to the top of a windmill,
Go on a short cycle tour of the Dutch countryside
Try traditional Dutch pancakes
- Day 3: We travel together to the IJssel Lake in the north of the country, where we'll board the 19th century sailing clipper, the Broedertrouw, meet our experienced skipper and receive the necessary training
Sleep on the boat
- Day 4/5/6: Sailing, swimming & fun
Sleep on the boat
Visiting picturesque Dutch fishing villages such as Enkhuizen and Volendam
And - of course - Amsterdam!
There'll also be a museum and cultural visit as well as time for shopping
- Day 7: Farewell party back at the homestay camp.

The Broedertrouw sailing clipper

Broedertrouw is a traditional wooden merchant sailing vessel built in 1882. Following a complete renovation, it is now a group hotel ship with the latest amenities, for a fabulous holiday. There are 15 2-person cabins each have a washbasin with running water and there are communal showers and toilets on board. As a group, you'll prepare breakfast, lunch and dinner together in the galley kitchen (kombuis) and dine in the elegant dining room.

With 2 masts, the Broedertrouw looks spectacular under full sail, but it is also equipped with an engine to ensure
