Ferrari land the only Ferrari Park in Europa, Caribbean Aquatic Park tropical aquatic adventure.

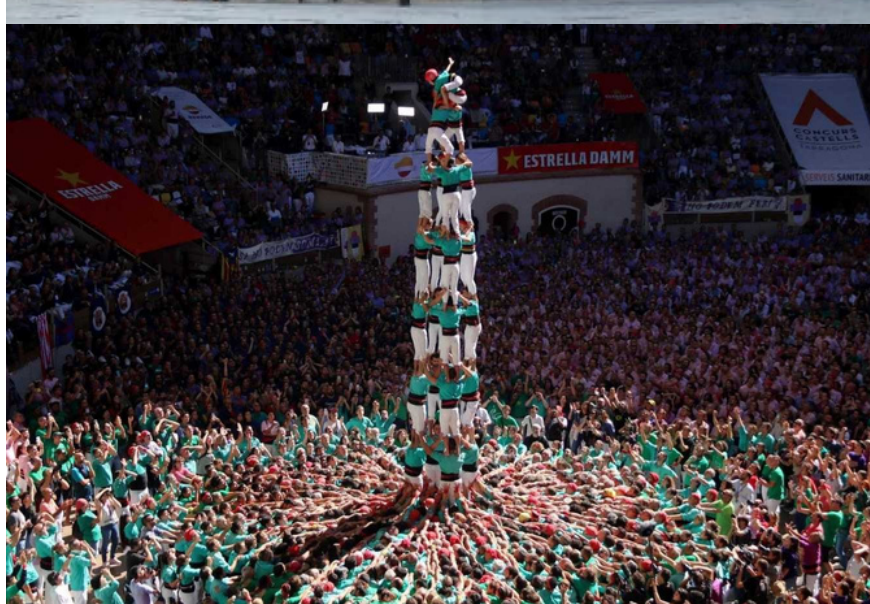
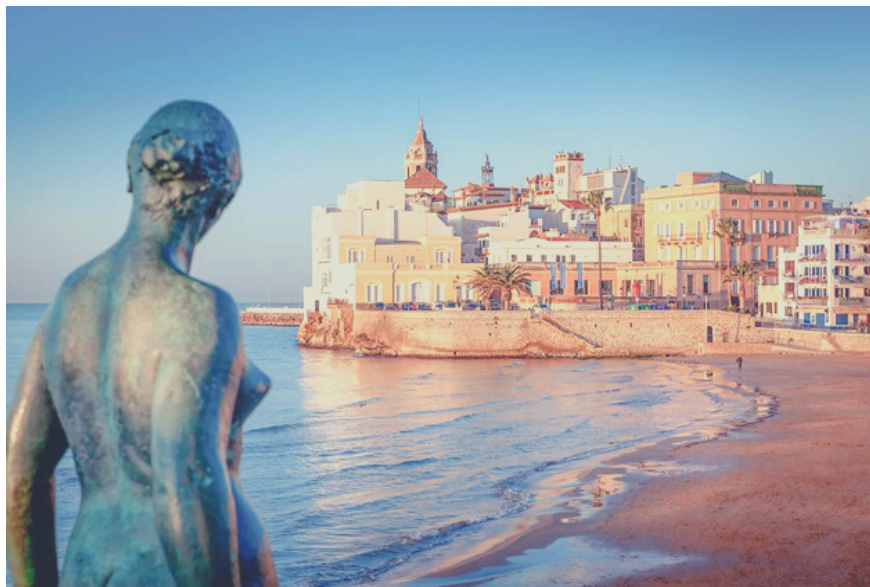
11TH JULY (MONDAY) SITGES AND VILAFRANCA DEL PENEDÈS

The Hostel is a non-profit organization which has as its mission the labour and social inclusion of people with disabilities who are part of the professional staff working there.

90% of the staff are people with disabilities. 100% of the staff have indefinite contracts and there is parity in the presence of men and women in the workforce.

Transfer to Plaça Catalunya

There, we will meet our official guide in order to start our tour through the history of Barcelona with a walk around Ciutat Vella, the historical city center.

We will see how a 1st century Roman camp became one of the most Cosmopolitan the medieval footprint looking at the building (original or reconstructed) the successive city walls.

Legend and mysteries of the city, old convents and monasteries, La Rambla, the neuralgic centre of the capital, and the most inhospitable and historical Gothic corners of El Raval and El Born.

Visit the new Wax Museum of Barcelona opens its doors as a 21st century museum, but without losing its impressive architecture and history.

In the heart of the city, in the old Bank of Barcelona headquarters, the museum is now inhabited by some the most emblematic.



The Gran Teatre del Liceu, built in 1847, is a unique cultural facility in Barcelona and one of the most outstanding opera houses in Europe.

Located on La Rambla, it hosts great opera, ballet and symphonic music productions every year. The building was destroyed by fire in 1994 and reopened in 1999 after a splendid reconstruction.

Lunch at the **Can Cullarettes** restaurant, the oldest in Catalonia, dating from 1786 and the second in Spain.

At the end of lunch afternoon free.

At 8:30 p.m. we will meet at the **Alaire Terrace**, of the Condes de Barcelona hotel, in the hearts of Paseo de Gracia. This avenue is commemorating the 200th anniversary of this creation.

Farewell dinner attended by representatives of the Rotary Club of Igualada, the Rotary Club of Vilafranca del Penedès and the Rotary Club of Barcelona Alba.

Return to Inout Hostel Barcelona. Accommodation.
