



## Cartagena Summer Camp 2023 | July 17<sup>th</sup> - 30<sup>th</sup> | Archaeological Heritage

Through this eminently practical and collaborative task carried out in morning schedule the participants will be in direct contact with remains archaeological sites of two thousand years ago and will acquire an approximate knowledge of the archaeological methodology, as well as the value of the archaeological heritage as an identity element of the communities.

The field work will be completed with visits to the most emblematic of Cartagena, both in the archaeological field (**Roman theater and forum**), as well as in fortifications (**Castillo de la Concepción, Castle of the Moors, Batteries of Conejos and Aguilones**), with respect to **Modernist Cartagena (Palacio consistorial and route through the city)**. Without forgetting, visits to certain museums unique as the **Theater Museum, the Military Museum and the Archaeological Museum Municipal**.

There will also be theoretical classes on archeology and the history of **Cartagena** city. Completing the course are various recreational and sports activities.
