The program will take place in cities such as **Curitiba** – the most ecological city in **Brazil**, **Morretes** – a historic town surrounded by the Atlantic Forest that offers a beautiful train ride through the Serra do Mar, and **Vila Velha State Park**, famous for its ancient sandstone rock formations. In addition, the CAMP will offer **technical visits** to companies that are references in sustainability and environmental practices!
